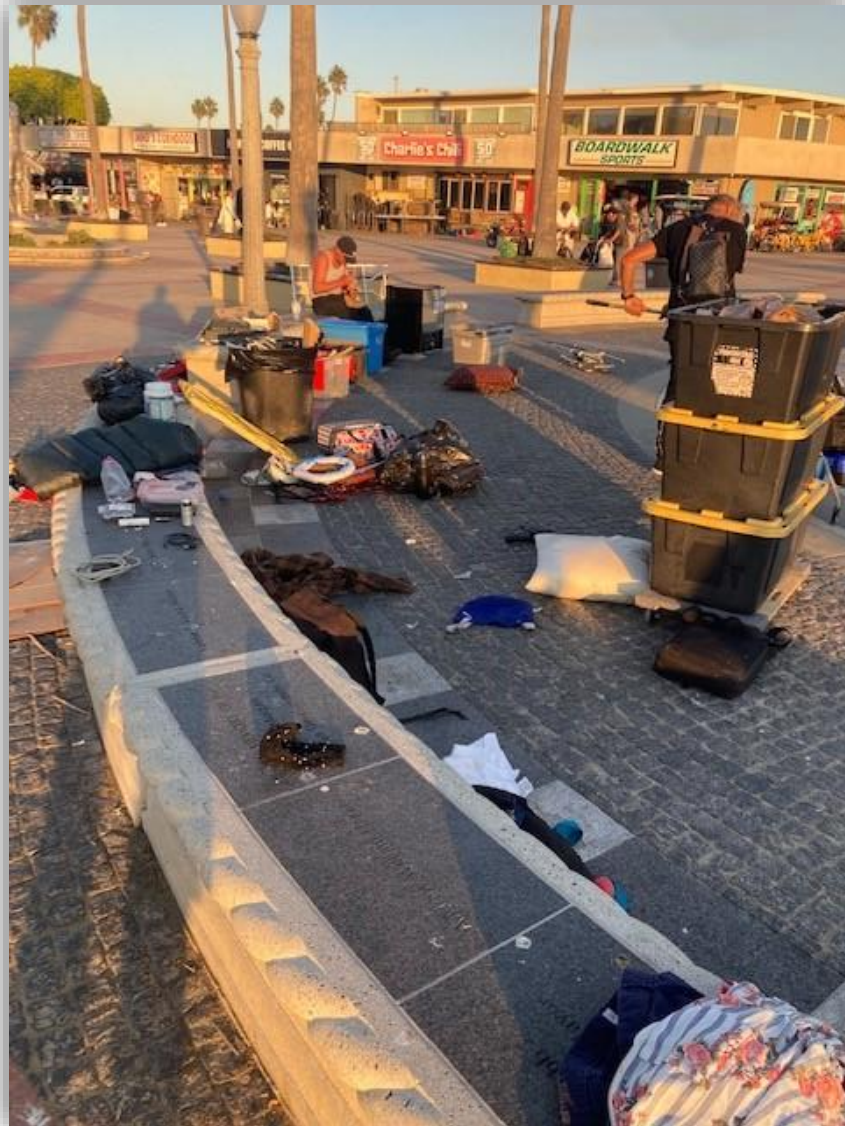

NBPD 2023 by the Numbers

2023 Dispatch Calls

- **Total Phone Calls Handled in Dispatch:** 169,371 (includes outgoing calls)
- **Total CAD Events Entered:** 101,945

- **Number of 911 Calls Answered:** 40,940
- **Answered in 15 seconds:** 99.85%
- **Answered in 10 seconds:** 99.54%
- **Number of days w/ 100% of calls answered within 10 seconds:** 259



2023 Response Times + Arrests

- **Number of Priority 1 Calls***: 57 (includes some field initiated calls)
- **Average response time for Priority 1 Call***: 3:00
- **Number of Priority 2 Calls***: 3,986
- **Average response time for Priority 2 Call***: 5:57

- **Total Arrests**: 2,566
(Approximately 7 per day)

Crime Reporting Transition

UCR/SRS → NIBRS

- New System for reporting crime numbers to FBI
 - More offenses reported (vs. the hierarchy system used prior)
 - New crime categories captured (for example: gambling, bribery, society offenses)
 - Crimes categorized differently. Examples:
 - Robbery has been changed from violent crime to property crime.
 - Burglary from Motor Vehicle & Theft from Motor vehicle now separate categories
- Main Challenge: Comparing year over year numbers until we build up more data in this new system

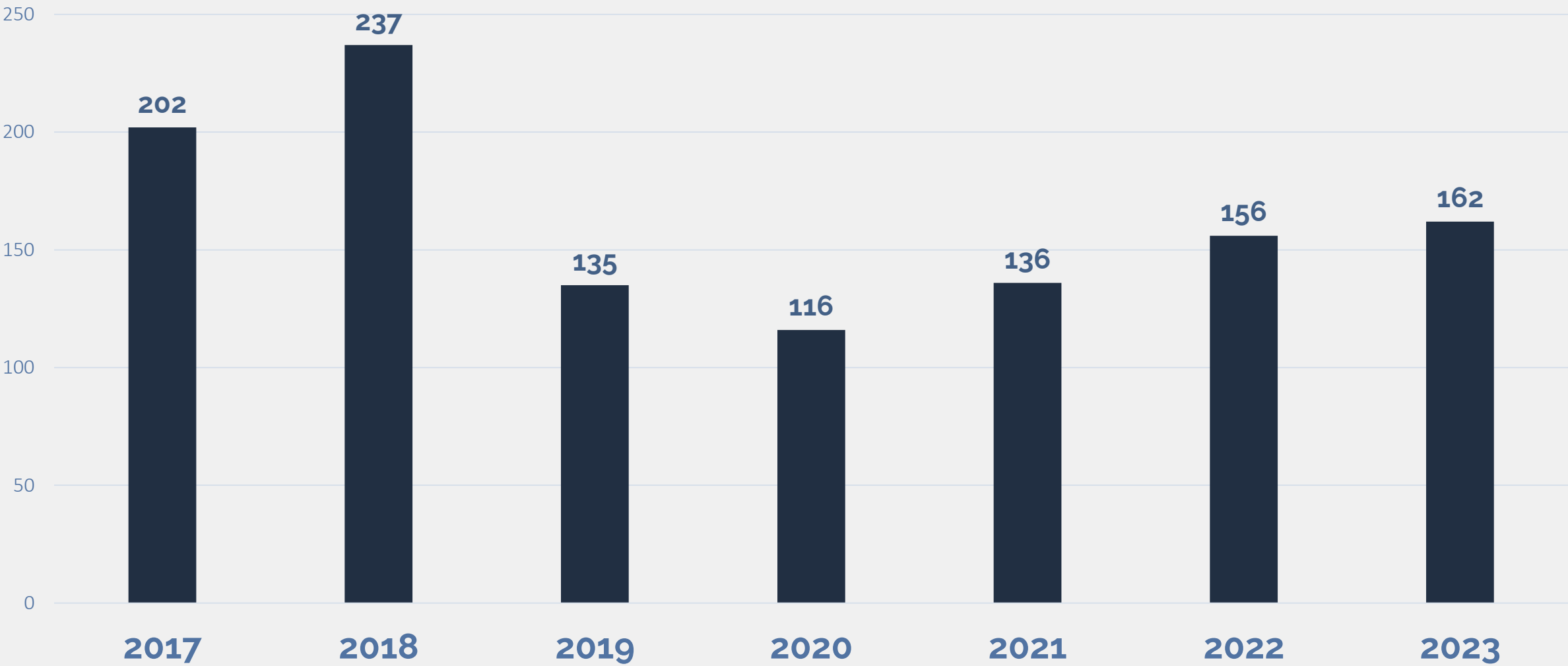

Year-Over-Year Residential Burglaries in Newport Beach

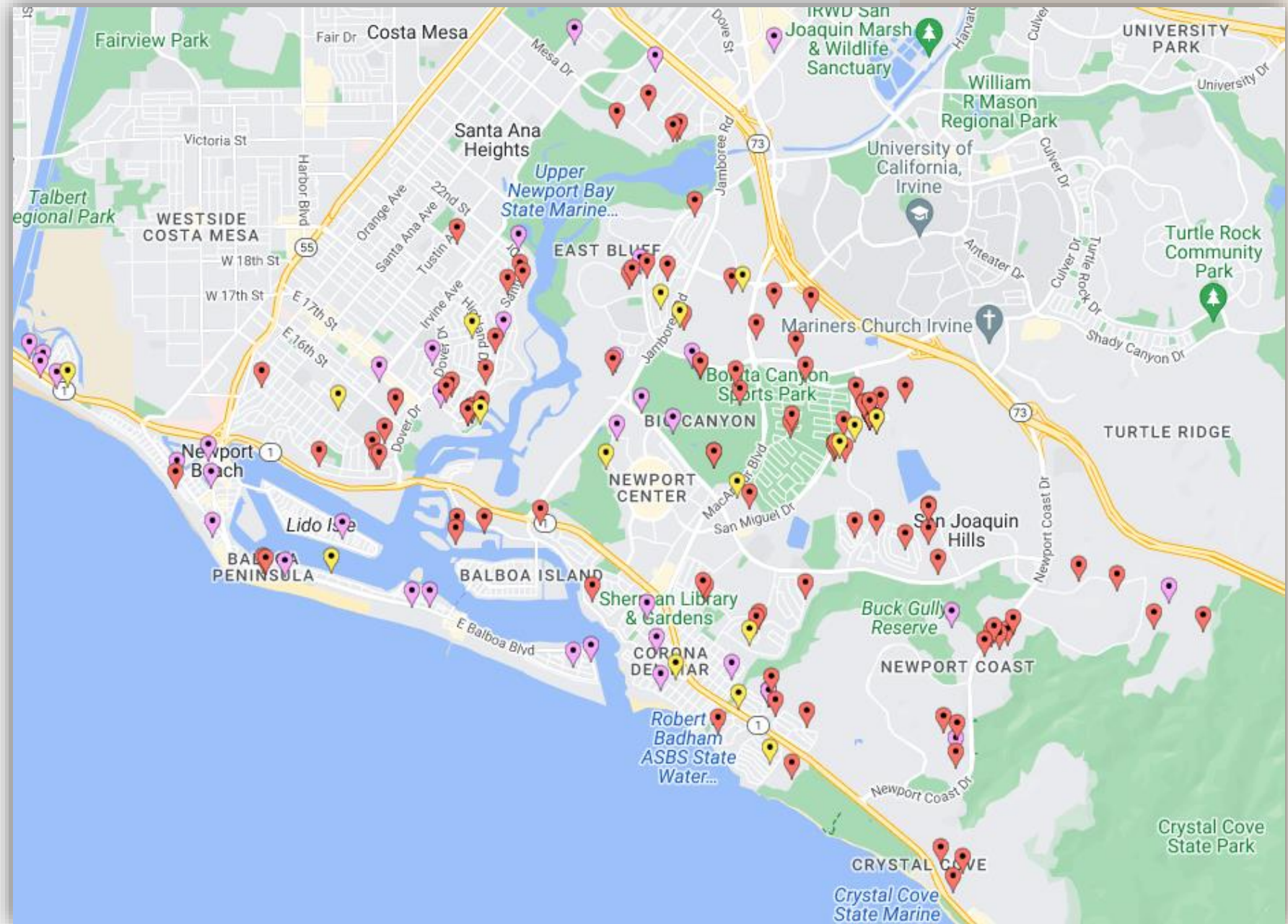
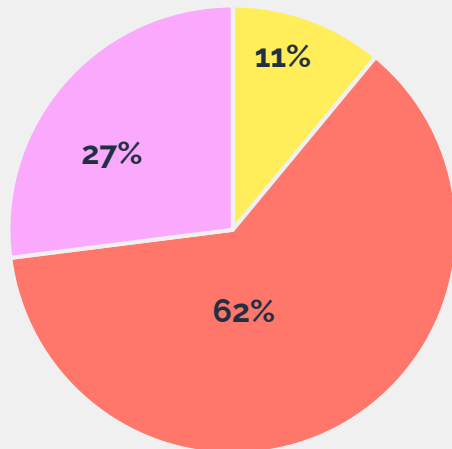


January 1 – December 31 of each year

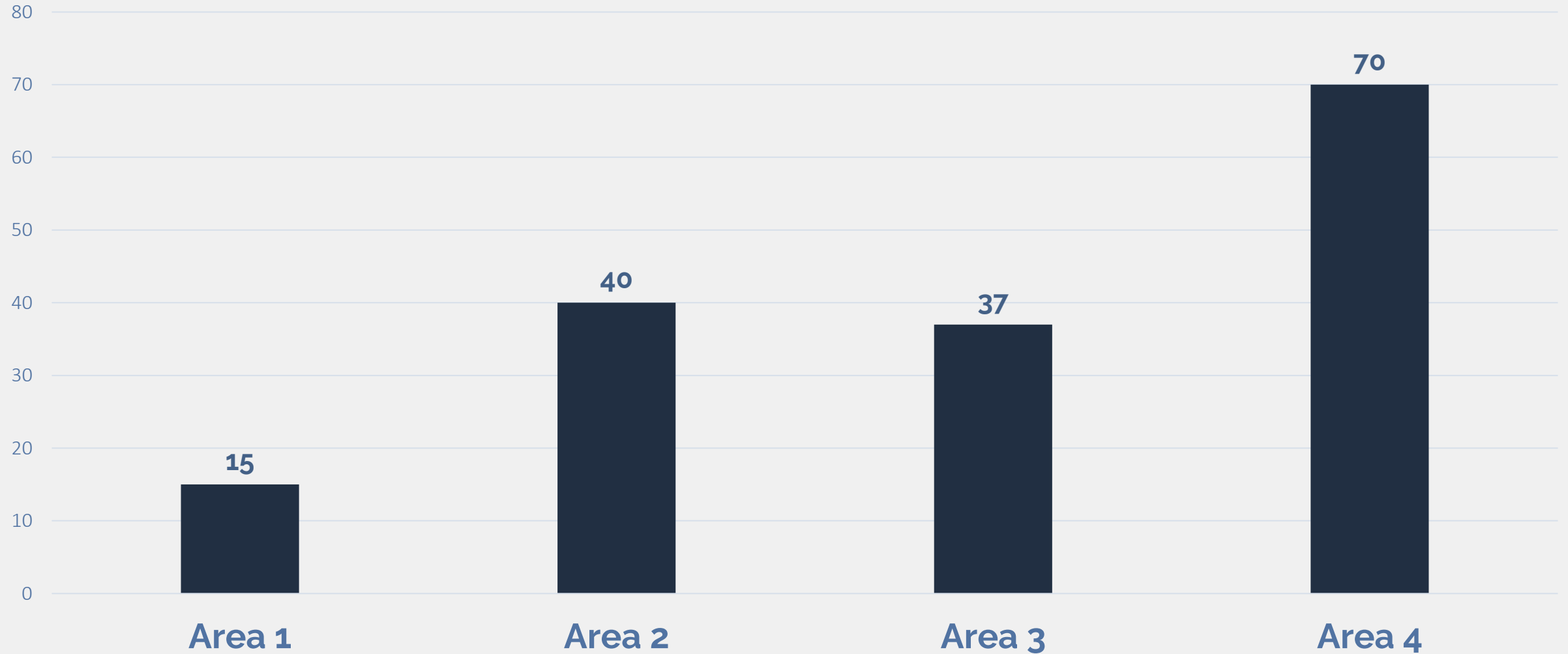


2023 Residential Burglaries

TRENDS + PATTERNS

- Day of the Week: Daily, mostly Friday + Saturday
- Time of Day: 5:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m.
- Empty homes targeted
- Dinnertime/early evening hours (shortly after sunset)
- Entry Points:
 - Sides of house/backyards
 - Shattering glass doors/windows
 - 2nd story balconies
- Master Bedroom targeted
 - Master closet

NEW TRENDS?

- Apartments/condos
- Unlocked doors
- Pried doors/tampered locks

Mail Theft Info

Trends:

- Late night and early morning hours
- Targets: residential curbside mailboxes, multi-unit residential mailboxes, and publicly accessible blue U.S. Postal Service boxes
- Looking for: documents containing personal info, checks and cash
- “Fishing”: using glue traps or glue-covered items to “fish” for mail
- P.O. Box Tampering



Prevention:

- Collect your mail daily, preferably, as soon as it is delivered.
- Avoid mailing any item containing your personal information, checks, or cash.
 - If you must mail those items, hand the mail to U.S. Postal Service employees or use a secure U.S. Postal Service Facility.



Garage Burglary Prevention Tip: Remote Lock



The “Remote Lock” button will disable the remote and external keypad from working. Considering using:

- When on vacation
- At night
- When parking outside your garage (if your remote is programmed into your vehicle)
- If your garage remote is lost or stolen
