Harbor Control & Mooring Rents Under the Microscope

Dec. 16 | State Lands Commission | Item 105

- Considering acceptance of an 823-page Public Trust Lands report
- Report supports 2024 mooring rent changes, but flags pier vs.
 mooring rent disparity
- City must file a progress report within 6 months
- Long-term: could affect the City's control over the harbor if issues aren't corrected

Jan. 8, 2026 | 6:00 p.m. | Planning Commission

- Proposal: 150 luxury condos
- Two towers up to 270 feet
- Would replace Edwards Newport Cinemas

Airport Area Zoning Overhaul Begins?

Jan. 13, 2026 | 4:00 p.m. | City Council

- Council may authorize work on an Airport Area Specific Plan
- Would create new zoning rules unique to the Airport Area
- Could shape development patterns for years
